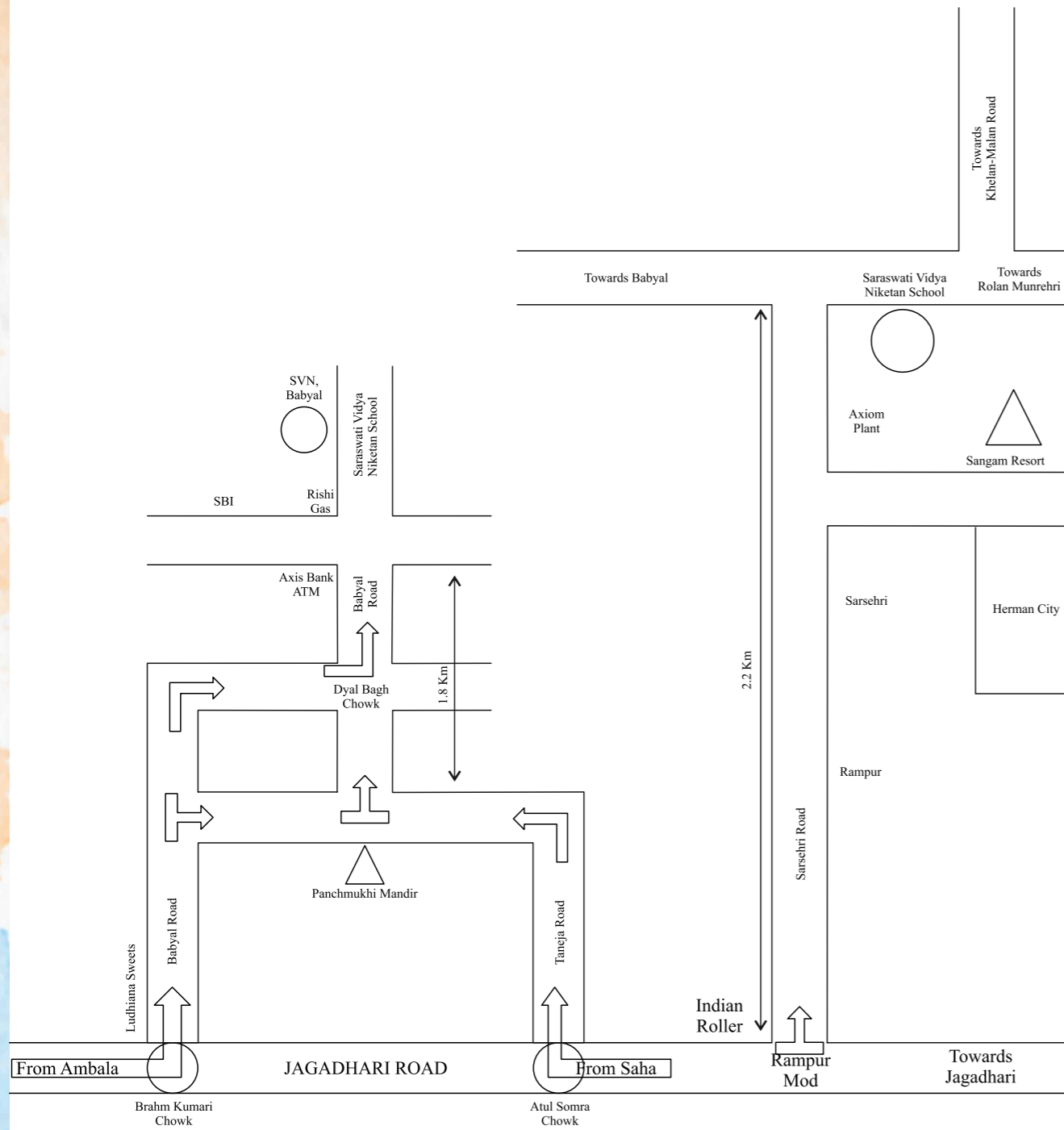

Dear Parents,

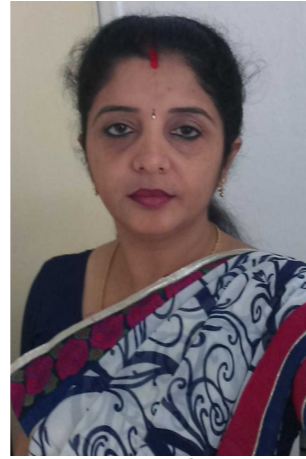

Admission Process

Admission is open to all children irrespective of caste, creed, religion or region subject to rules of the Saraswati Vidya Niketan.

Registration to play school commences in December itself on a first-come, first serve basis. Registration to other classes is subject to availability of seats and preparedness of the child for the class in which admission is sought.

Eligible age for seeking admission in class nursery is 3 years as on 1st April.

Relaxation of two months is permitted at the discretion of the Principal. No further relaxation in this regard will be made under any circumstances, as it is not in the interest of the children, to admit them if they are underage.

Classes I to XI

Parents are required to apply for admission on the application form given in the prospectus with latest result from the school in which the child was studying along with a copy of the birth certificate, before last date.

Registration is no guarantee for admission. Admission to these classes are given on the basis of vacancies resulting due to withdrawals. The age at which a child is admitted in class I, is 6 on 1st April of the year of entry. Prospectus and application form for admission can be obtained from the office by paying the registration fees.

Documents to be attached with the application form

1. 2-recent passport size photographs pasted on the space provided in the application form.
2. Photocopy of birth certificate duly attested issued by the competent authority as proof of age.
3. Original Transfer Certificate in case child seeking admission in Ist or above from the school last attended .
4. Documents in support of claim as SC/ST/OBC issued by competent authority.
5. Blind, Dyslexic, Deaf, Spastic, Handicapped candidates are requested to submit a medical certificate/document supporting their disability/disorder & its extent.

Instructions

- Incomplete application form and application not signed by the parents will be rejected.
- Application form should be duly filled and submitted in the office within 7-days of registration. No application will be accepted after the closing date in any circumstances.
- Candidate who claims to belong to SC or ST or OBC should submit in support of his/her claim an attested copy of certificate from the competent authority. List of authority empowered to issue caste certificate District Magistrate Additional DM, Collector, Deputy Commissioner, Dy. Collector, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Executive Magistrate.
- All the mentioned certificates must be attached along with the application form at the time of admission.

Rules of Withdrawal

Three-month advance notice must be given to the Principal in writing as per the school's prescribed format.

The parents who want to withdraw their wards after the final result is declared must inform the authorities in writing by the last working day of the current session otherwise he/she will have to pay the full amount of dues in the next session including all the dues and tuition fee for the month of April.

Academics Information

SVN follows the Central Board of Secondary Education, NCERT syllabus and uses English as medium of instruction. The national language and regional languages are given due importance.

Extra-curricular Activities

Meaningful education is much more than mere academic excellence. The emotional faculties of students should be developed by a range of extra-curricular activities at school. Adequate emphasis is given to sports and games to build up the physical and mental endurance of students. Literary and cultural competitions are organized every year to unearth and encourage the latent talents of students.

Financial Information

The first installment of the fee for the academic year is payable on or before 10th April for all students on roll. The fee will be deposited at the school campus from 1st to the 15th of every month after the 15th fee will be deposited in IDBI Bank, Punjabi Mohalla, Nicholson Road, Ambala Cantt.

Those seeking fresh admission will be advised on mode of payments, date etc. in the selection intimation, sent by the office.

Payment of the fees is strictly according to the fees schedule leaving nothing due by 10 Feb, of each academic year, otherwise the child shall not be allowed to sit for the Final Examination.

The school welcomes payments on or before the due date. Late payments are strongly discouraged as it causes a lot of problems. Parents shall take care to remit the correct amount and add late fee if paid after the due date as specified in Fee Rules of the Prospectus.

If any clarification is required parents are requested to contact the office personally or write to the Principal.

Fee Rules

- The due date for all payments will be the 10 of every month. If 10th happens to be a public holiday, next working day will be considered as due date.
- Late fee of Rs. 10/-per day inclusive of holidays will be levied there after.
- After the 20th of the month the defaulter's name will be removed from the rolls of the school and will be allowed to continue only after paying all dues along with a reactivation fee of Rs. 150 -over and above the late fee as detailed above.
- Fee once paid will not be refunded.
- A student who attends any part of a term is required to pay the prescribed fees for the entire term.
- Those who are making the payment through cheque, must write the name of the child in respect with admission no., residential address and telephone numbers at the back of the cheque.
