- **21**st **century skills (Critical thinking, creativity, communication and collaborative learning):** A broad set of knowledge, skills, work habits, and character traits that are believed to be critically important to achieve success in today's world include Creative, Critical, Collaborative and Communication skills which will be reflected in the method of teaching --learning.

Notebooks:

- Notebooks should always be kept neat and properly labeled.
- Parents to supervise the notebooks and sign the index column regularly.

<u>Reinforcement of Concepts</u>:

- Students will be given appropriate and optimum assignments to reinforce the concepts taught in school.
- Kindly encourage your child to do all his/her home assignments on his/her own, to develop selfdiscipline, confidence and a sense of responsibility.

<u>Extra Edge:</u>

- Mental Ability Testing (MAT): To help the students prepare in a better way for competitive exams and to have an edge over others in future.
- STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics): Visit to Atal Tinkering Lab(ATL), Science and Computer laboratories will be a regular features to foster curiosity, creativity and imagination in young minds and inculcate skills such as design mindset, computational thinking, adaptive learning, physical computing etc.
- **Health and Physical Education:** Sports is an important aspect of education at OPBMS. We aim to keep our students physically and emotionally fit to handle the challenges of life in a better way. A complete sports syllabus is planned and will be delivered for a holistic and healthy lifestyle.
