# **Instructional Mode:**

• Experiential Learning: Experiential Learning is the primary mode of teaching —learning process at OPBMS. Hands-on learning, technology integration and sports integration will be essential components of innovative pedagogical practices.

- Competency Based Learning: Classroom transactions will be based on Competency Based Learning. The aim is to help the students learn through experience and activity than through rote learning and memorization. The focus will be on key concepts, ideas, application and problem solving with greater depth.
- 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills: A broad set of knowledge, skills, work habits, and character traits that are believed to be critically important to achieve success in today's world include Creative, Critical, Collaborative and Communication skills will be reflected in the method of teaching learning.
- Art Integrated Learning: Art Integrated Learning is a teaching-learning model which is based on learning 'through the arts' and 'with the arts'. It is a process where art becomes the medium of teaching-learning, a key to understanding concepts within any subject of the curriculum. Students explore creatively while building connections between different concepts through various art forms.

# **Extra Edge in the school:**

- **Performing Arts:** With the vision to foster artistic excellence in performing arts, School Kala Sangam programme has been initiated in collaboration with Pracheen Kala Kendra, Chandigarh. Further on, concerts, workshops will be organised by SPIC MACAY Heritage Club, a non-profit voluntary movement which is working for the promotion of Indian classical music, arts and culture through and other related activities.
- NCC (Class VI onwards): Introduction of National Cadet Corps (NCC) a prominent youth organization fostering the growth of character, discipline and leadership qualities among young individuals.
- Mental Ability Testing (MAT- Class-IV & V): To help the students prepare a better way for competitive exams and have an extra edge over others in future.
- Mathematical Skills: Students will be given exposure to hands on experience in NIIT Maths Lab to sharpen their mathematical skills.
- **Foreign Language:** Students can study French language in collaboration with Alliance Franchise Chandigarh as an optional subject from class IV onwards.
