Highlights of Curriculum

- **Competency based education:** Classroom transactions will be based on Competency Based Learning. The aim is to help the students learn through experience and activity than through rote learning and memorization. The focus will be on key concepts, ideas, application and problem solving with greater depth.
- **Experiential learning:** Experiential Learning is the primary mode of teaching–learning process at OPBMS. Hands-on learning, art integration, technology integration and sports integration will be essential components of innovative pedagogical practices.
- **Art integration activities:** Art Integrated Learning (AIL) is a teaching-learning model which is based on learning ‘through the arts’ and ‘with the arts’: it is a process where art becomes the medium of teaching-learning, a key to understanding concepts within any subject of the curriculum.
- **21st century skills (Critical thinking, creativity, communication and collaborative learning):** A broad set of knowledge, skills, work habits, and character traits that are believed to be critically important to achieve success in today’s world include - Creative, Critical, Collaborative and Communication skills which will be reflected in the method of teaching –learning.

Extra Edge:

- **Mental Ability Testing (MAT):** To help the students prepare in a better way for competitive exams and have an edge over others in future.
- **Foreign Language:** Students can study French language as an optional subject at school in collaboration with Alliance Franchise Chandigarh.
- **STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics):** Visit to **Atal Tinkering Lab (ATL)**, Science and Computer laboratories will be a regular feature to foster curiosity, creativity and imagination in young minds and inculcate skills such as design mindset, computational thinking, adaptive learning, physical computing etc.
- **Health and Physical Education:** Sports is an important aspect of education at OPBMS. We aim to keep our students physically and emotionally fit to handle the challenges of life in a better way. A complete sports syllabus is planned along with Morning School Sports Enrichment program that aims to be delivered for a holistic and healthy lifestyle.
- **Olympiads:** Students will be able to enhance their skills by participating in various Olympiad Examination like International Science Olympiad (ISO), International Maths Olympiad (IMO), English International Olympiad (EIO), General Knowledge International Olympiad (GKIO), and International Computer Olympiad (ICO).
- **Performing Arts:** With the vision to foster artistic excellence in performing arts, School Kala Sangam programme has been initiated in collaboration with Pracheen Kala Kendra, Chandigarh. Further on, concerts, workshops will be organised by SPIC MACAY Heritage Club, a non-profit voluntary movement which is working for the promotion of Indian classical music, arts and culture through and other related activities.
- **National Cadets Corps:** Introduction of National Cadet Corps (NCC) a prominent youth organization fostering the growth of character, discipline and leadership qualities among young individuals.

- **Allen School Integrated Program** for Class 8th, 9th, 10th & 11th (Sci.) Students will be delivered in school campus. School academics will be delivered along with competitive coaching. SIP will create a perfect balance between self-study and coaching studies. It will also ensure holistic personality development of the students.
- **National Service Scheme:** A scheme by Government of India , provides opportunity to the students to participate in various government led community service activities and programs.

School Diary:

- The school diary will be given to your child in the first week of April.
- It is mandatory for students to carry it to school and maintain it regularly.
- Students Personal Record given on Pg. no.1 of the school diary is to be filled by parents themselves in legible handwriting and one copy of the same must be submitted to the respective Class Incharge. Paste a passport size photograph of your child in school uniform in the given space.
- Pages referring to medical information of the child must be filled carefully and mention the name and address of your personal doctor if in case of emergency school needs to contact.
- Diary must be thoroughly read by the child as well as parents and the page referring to as **Declaration by Parents** must be signed by parents and submitted to respective Class In charge.

Reinforcement of Concepts:

- You are requested to supervise your ward's study routine at home and facilitate the concept of Experiential

Learning.

School bag:

- You are requested to ensure that your ward packs his/her bag as per the daily time-table to avoid carrying un-necessary weight.
- Books and Notebooks should be covered, labelled properly and should always be kept neat.

Attendance:

- We highly appreciate the regularity in attendance to achieve the desired learning goals.
- 75% attendance is a must for a student to be promoted to next class.
